- 3  3 MEASURING TAPE
- 4  4 SCISSORS
- 5  5 THREAD

A STRAIGHT STITCH

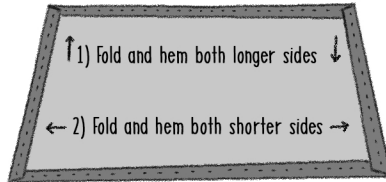
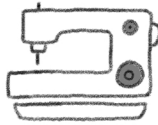


1 PLACE OUTER LAYER
RIGHT SIDE UP

Right Side = Darker

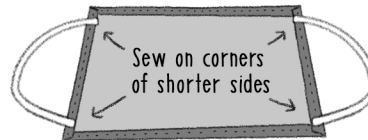
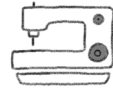
Wrong Side = Lighter

* Hem seams should be 0.6cm wide

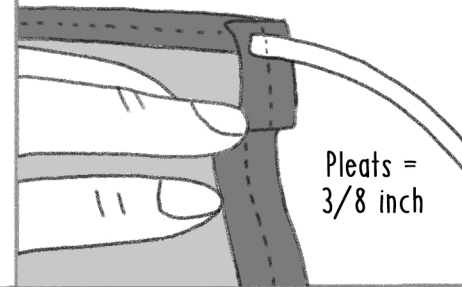
3 SEW ON THE

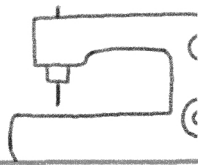
4 FOLD THE PLEATS

3X (on each of the shorter sides)

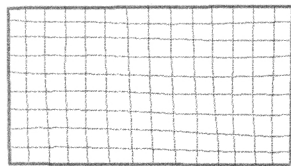

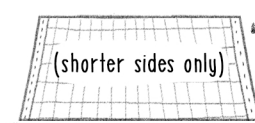
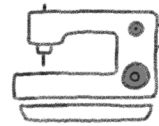

THE SIDES

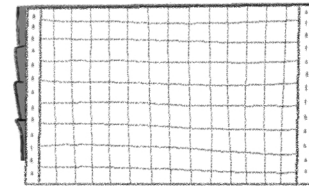


Repeat on other side
