It was God who made the world.

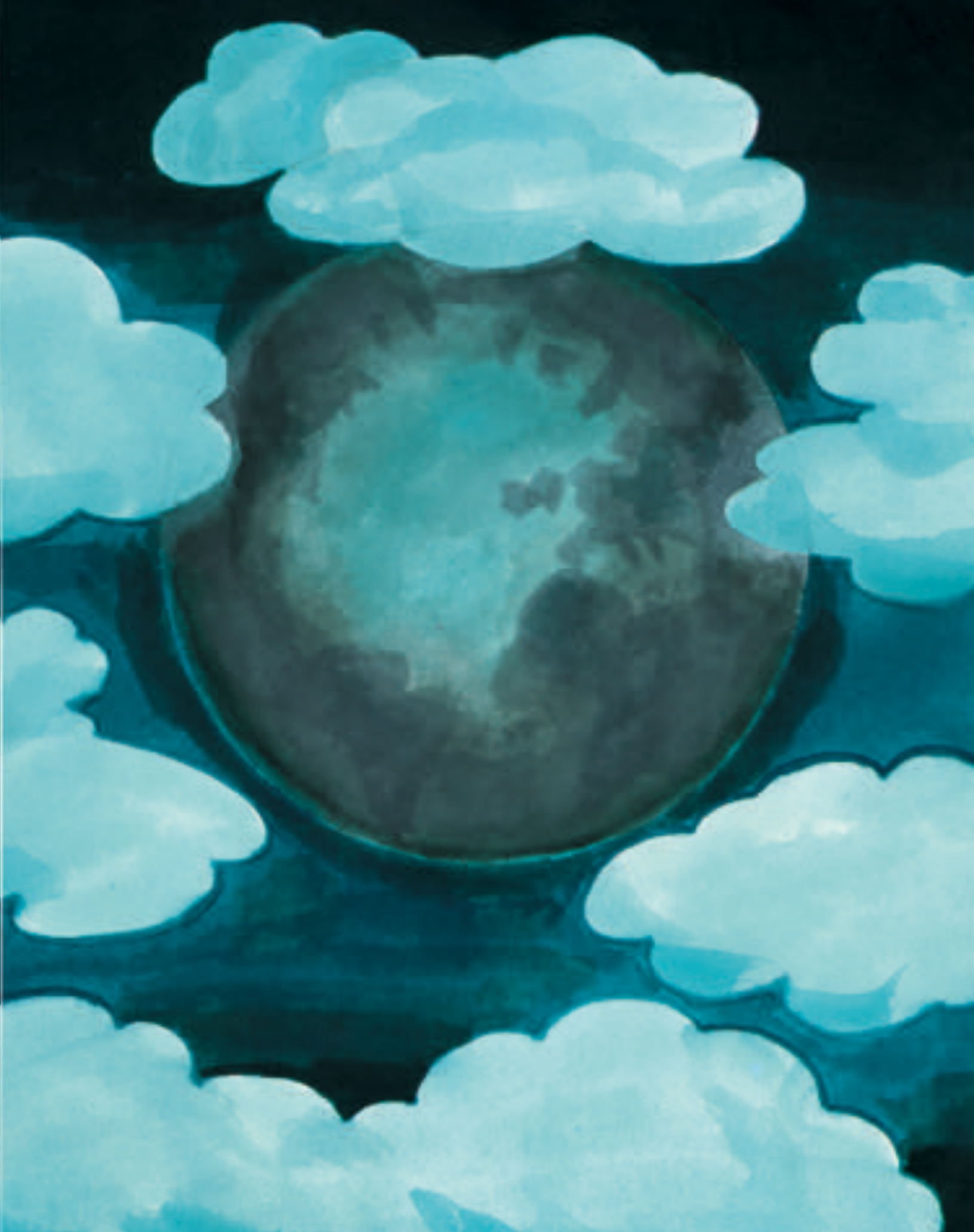


God said, "Come, light!"

He called the dark NIGHT.




Then God said,
