


Bracelet Size Guide

We recommend the use of a ruler within this size guide to facilitate you in acquiring the correct size of your wrist.

Before proceeding with the process, please make sure that the document is printed on an A4 sheet of paper and your scale is at 100%. This will result in the printing of the document's true dimensions.



Acquiring an accurate reading of your wrist is integral to finding out your best fit. This will allow us to make the necessary considerations for the piece, to adorn you effortlessly.

Please find the ruler on the right hand side of this page.

How to Use the Ruler

- 1. Cut around the outline of the ruler.
- 2. At the white dotted line make a slit through the paper. This horizontal opening will be utilised to assist you in taking your reading.
- 3. With the numbers side visible (on top) wrap the ruler around your wrist.
- 4. Slide the numbered side through the opening and slowly tighten the ruler until you feel it is skin tight.
 - **5.** The size that is visible and lined up next to the edge of the opening is the size of your wrist, measured in centimetres (cm).

If for any reason you feel uncertain about your size, please feel free to contact us for assistance.

Alternatives do include, of course, visiting a reputable jeweller in your area to receive a confident reading.



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
