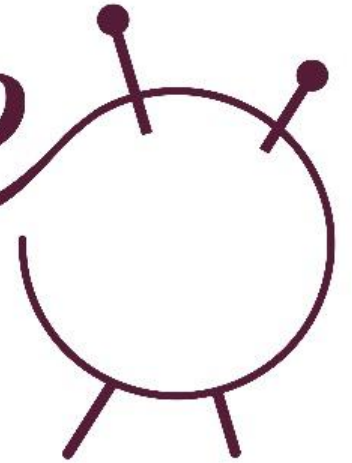


Knit Me

All-Weather Wrap



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 100g (200g) of Dk yarn
- 5.5mm needles
- 6mm needles
- 2 stitch markers

Gauge for Section A: 19st/4"

Gauge for Section B: 21st/4"

NOTES

- This pattern has the instructions for both the cozy and extra cozy size. The measurements for the extra cozy are in brackets following the cozy measurement, in this format "C (EC)".
- If not specified, instructions are the same for both sizes.
- To test your gauge for both sections, cast on an odd number of stitches and use the pattern repeat between the 3 edge stitches & the first marker/increase.
- Keep your tension loose in section b so that both sections have a similar gauge.
- When doing "m1r" or "m1l", be sure to pick up the bar from the last worked stitch, not the float from the slipped stitch.

GLOSSARY

kyok: knit into the stitch without slipping it off the left needle, yarn over, knit into the same stitch again. Increases the stitch count by 2.

m1l: inserting the needle from front to back, pick up the bar between the stitch you just knit and the one you're about to work, and knit it through the back loop.

m1r: inserting the needle from back to front, pick up the bar between the stitch you just knit and the one you're about to work, and knit it through the front loop.

pm: place stitch marker.

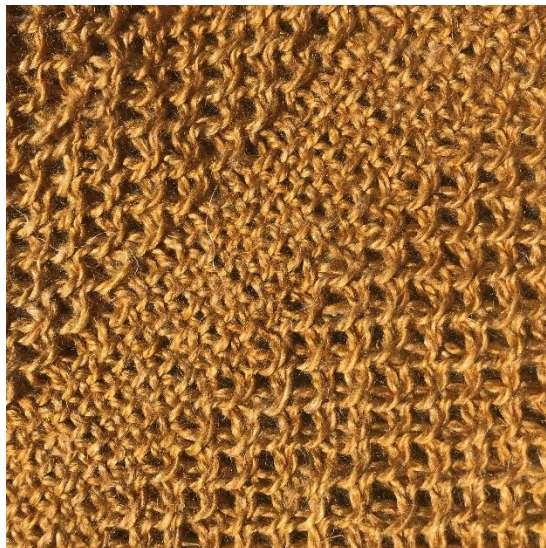
sm: slip stitch marker to the right needle.

sl: slip the next stitch onto the right needle without working it. Unless otherwise directed, slip stitches as if to purl.

wyib: this stitch is slipped with the working yarn held to the back of the work .

wyif: this stitch is slipped with the working yarn held to the front of the work.

yo: bring the yarn over the needle to create an extra stitch.



PATTERN

Set Up

Co 5 with smaller needles

R1: k2, kyok, k2

R2: sl, p to last, sl

R3: k2, kyok, pm, k, pm, kyok, k2

R4: sl, p2, k2, slwyif, k2, p2, sl

Section A

R1 (rs): k2, kyok, k to m, m1r, sm, k, sm, m1l, k to 3 stitches left, kyok, k2

R2 (ws): slwyif, p2, k, *slwyib, k* to m, sm, slwyif, sm, k, *slwyib, k* to 3 stitches left, p2, slwyif

R3: k2, kyok, k to m, m1r, sm, k, sm, m1l, k to 3 stitches left, kyok, k2

R4: slwyif, p2, *slwyib, k* to m, sm, slwyif, sm, *k, slwyib* to 3 stitches left, p2, slwyif

Repeat R1-4 until work measures ~3 (4)" from centre stitch to cast on edge, ending after R1.

Section B

Switch to larger needles

R1 (ws): slwyif, p3, *slwyib, p1* to m, sm, slwyif, sm, p1, *slwyib, p1* to 3 stitches left, p2, slwyif

R2 (rs): k2, kyok, slwyif, *k, slwyif* to m, m1r, sm, k, sm, m1l, slwyif, *k, slwyif* to 3 stitches left, kyok, k2

R3: slwyif, p2, *p1, slwyib* to m, sm, slwyif, sm, *slwyib, p1* to 3 stitches left, p2, slwyif

R4 (rs): k2, kyok, *slwyif, k* to m, m1r, sm, k, sm, m1l, *k, slwyif* to 3 stitches left, kyok, k2

Repeat R1-4 until Section B measures ~1.5 (2)", ending after R3.

Switch back to smaller needles.

Repeat sections A and B.

Repeat section A a final time, ending after R1 or 3. Switch to larger needles, and loosely bind off purlwise on the wrong side.
