


Knit Me



Rain Dyed Infinity Scarf Pattern



GLOSSARY

BOR

Beginning of round marker

K2tog

Knit two stitches together, for a right-leaning decrease.

P2tog

Purl two stitches together.

PM

Place the stitch marker.

RM

Remove the stitch marker.

SSK

Slip two stitches then knit them together, for a left-leaning decrease.

YO

Wrap the yarn over the needle to create a decorative increase.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 4mm circular needles (I used an 80cm cord)
- 100g of fingering weight yarn
- Darning needle

NOTES

This infinity scarf is knit in the round, so the length is fixed with the number of cast on stitches. But the width is totally customizable!

As written, the scarf wraps loosely twice around the neck to still cover the chest, or can be wrapped three times to form a cowl.

If you wish to adjust the length of the scarf, cast on more or fewer stitches in multiples of 16.

As with all lace, a gentle block when finished will provide the best results.

LACE CAST ON

1. Make a slip knot, leaving a tail ~4" long, and fit it snugly on the left needle.
2. Knit into the slip knot, but do not drop the first stitch from the needle.
3. Without twisting the orientation of the new stitch, place it on the left needle, and pull snug.
4. Repeat this until there are 256 stitches on the left needle (including the slip knot),
5. Place stitch marker to mark beginning of the round (BOR).

LACE PATTERN

Section 1

Round 1: *(ssk, yo)x4, k8* to end

Round 2: p1, *k7, p9* to last 8 st, p8

Repeat row 1-2 3 more times (4 times total)

On last repeat of round 2, set up section 1: rm, slip first stitch to right needle, pm

Section 2

Round 1: *k8, (yo, k2tog)x4*

Round 2: p8, *k7, p9* to last st, p1


Repeat row 1-2 3 more times (4 times total)

On last repeat of round 2, set up section 1: rm, slip last stitch to left needle, pm

Repeat sections 1 and 2 to desired width, ending on a round 2.

NOTE

The BOR shifts by 1 stitch with each section. Don't forget this step!



LACE BIND OFF

1. Purl the next two stitches
2. Slip the two stitches back onto the left needle, **without twisting**
3. Purl two together
4. Repeat until one stitch remains, cut yarn and pull through loop to finish

NOTE

Once you've sewn in the ends, gently block the scarf to open up the lace, and shape the scalloped edges.
