How To Use

01 PRINT AND CHECK YOUR SCALE! The following page should be printed without scaling on a standard letter 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper. Before you do any ring sizing, check the ruler at the bottom to make sure the measurements are accurate! If they are off, check your printer settings and make sure you are not scaling to fit.


MEASURE A RING

O3 MEASURE YOUR FINGER If you have a ring that you want to know the size of, simply use the circle template to match up the inside diameter with the ring. The lines below show the diameter at each size.

If you need to measure your hand, cut out the ring sizer (I suggest reinforcing with packing tape on both sides of the paper to "laminate"), cut a slit, and pull through to see your size. MAKE SURE YOU PULL THE TAB TIGHT AROUND YOUR FINGER TO GET A MORE ACCURATE SIZE! It will feel like you are pulling the paper too tight, but as long as you are not sizing for a very wide band ring, this will be more accurate.



A word of caution: Always check return policies with ring purchases. This sizer will get you close, but for a truly accurate measurement see your local jeweler!



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
