

Candy Dish

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Inside fabric (A) – 10" x 10"

Outside fabric (B) – 8" x 8"

Batting – 8" x 8"

Trace and cut out the large and small hexagons separately on hard card or template plastic. Mark the **Foldline** and the Center notch Δ on the templates.

Fold the inside fabric (A) in half. Place the large hexagon template **Foldline** on the fold of (A) and cut out. Repeat for outside fabric (B) and batting using the small hexagon template.

Place (A) right side down on ironing board. Press every second edge over 1/4", then press remaining three edges over 1/4". Press every second edge of (A) over again, but at 3/8", then press remaining three edges over at 3/8". This is a rolled edge.

Gently lift the rolled edges of (A) and place the batting down, matching the edges of the batting to the pressed edges of (A). Then place (B) right side up on batting.

Pin down the rolled edges. Machine top stitch (or hand blind stitch) along inside of the rolled edge.

Mark the center Δ of every second edge. Fold in half at the mark of one edge, outsides together. Machine stitch folded edge 1/8" from edge, backtacking at the start and end (or hand whip-stitch securing and knotting ends). Repeat for the other two sides.

Turn right side out and gently push the corners out with a point turner. Press the seams open. Done!
