

# Little Bird

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- Beak - Yellow - cut 1- 1 1/2" square
- Wings -Light - cut 2- 3" squares
- Upper body - Light - cut 1- 2" x 6"
- Lower body - Dark - cut 1- 3" x 6"
- Tail - Print - cut 1- 2" x 6"
- Magnet - 1" round
- Fibrefill



Diagram A: Fold beak and wings.

Diagram B: On right sides of fabric place A) Beak 1/4" from fold line on upper body and B) Wings 1/2" from fold line on lower body. Baste down.

Place upper body side X, right sides together, on lower body side X. Stitch together. Place tail fabric, right sides together, on lower body side Y. Stitch together. Press seams towards upper body and tail.

Fold bird right sides together. Using template trim back the bird's tummy along the green line. Stitch along seam allowance according to template. Snip 5-6 notches, up to the thread, along curve. Press seam open.

Glue magnet to seam allowance according to placement on template.

Turn bird right side out. Fold in tail 1/2" from seam according to template. Stuff with fibrefill to 1" from folded end.

Diagram C: Fold bird in half and place two pins centered lengthwise. Squeeze top fold and bottom seam together to meet with pins. Stitch 1" parallel from folded end of tail. Sew small glass beads on or make French knots for the eyes. Done!

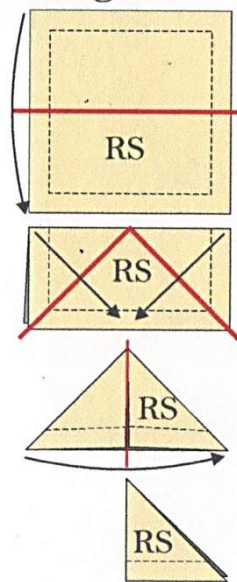

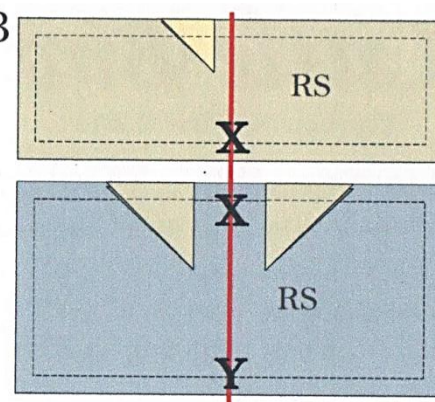
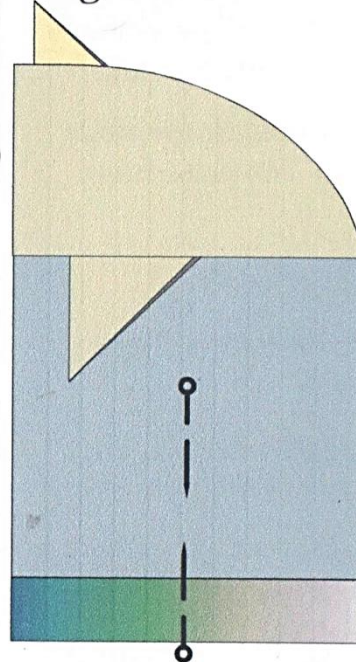
