

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Additional Requirements

- 100% cotton thread in colors to match
- 56" x 68" (142.24cm x 172.72cm) batting

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabrics A-H, L, and M, cut from each: (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF (17.46cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " (17.46cm) squares

Fabrics I, J, and N-T, cut from each: (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (8.89cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (8.89cm) squares

Fabric K, cut:

(1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (8.89cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (8.89cm) squares (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (6.35cm x WOF), for binding

Fabric U, cut:

(8) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF (9.84xm x WOF); sub-cut (80) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " (9.84cm) squares

Sewing

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together.

Note: Prints are all considered non-directional.

1. Cut all 3%" (9.84cm) **Fabric U** and 6%" (17.46cm) print squares in half once diagonally **(Fig. 1)**.



2. Sew (2) $3^{7}/8$ " (9.84cm) **Fabric U** triangles to a randomly selected $3^{1}/2$ " (8.89cm) print square **(Fig. 2)**.

3. Add a randomly selected $6\frac{7}{8}$ " (17.46cm) print triangle to complete a block (**Fig. 3**). Make a total of 80 assorted blocks (**Fig. 4**).

Quilt Top Assembly

- **4.** Following the **Quilt Layout** diagram on page 4 for orientation, arrange the blocks into (10) rows of (8) blocks each.
- **5.** Sew the blocks together into rows, pressing seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows. Sew the rows together in order. Press the seams in one direction.



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Finishing

- **6.** Sew together the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (6.35cm x WOF) **Fabric K** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 7. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 8. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to ½" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **9.** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
