## Fabric B, cut:

(2) $41 / 2{ }^{11} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (12)
$41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric C, cut:

(1) $41 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (8) $41 / 2$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric Q, cut:

(2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (14) $41 / 2$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Fabric R, cut:

(1) $41 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (5) $41 / 2$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares
(6) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times \mathrm{W}$ WOF ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF), for inner border
(7) $2^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF), for binding

## Fabric S, cut:

(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF); sub-cut (8)
$41 / 2$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

## Sewing

All seam allowances are $1 / 4 "(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Arrange the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares in (19) diagonal rows as shown, noting the orientation of striped squares. Stitch the squares together in each diagonal row, pressing seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows. Sew the rows together in order (Fig. 1) and press seams in one direction.
2. Trim the quilt center to $453 / 44^{\prime \prime} \times 57^{\prime \prime}$ ( $116.21 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), allowing $1 / 4$ " (.64cm) beyond the triangle points for seaming (Fig. 2). Baste the edges of quilt center to keep the bias-cut edges from stretching.
3. Following the Quilt Layout diagram on page 5, add the borders. Sew (6) $11 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) Fabric $\mathbf{R}$ strips together end to end. Cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 57$ " $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm})$ borders. Sew a border strip to each side of the quilt top. From the remaining strip, cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 473 / 4$ " 3.81 cm $x 121.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew (1) border to the top and another to the bottom of the quilt top.
4. Sew the (6) $3^{\prime \prime} \times \mathrm{WOF}$ ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times \mathrm{WOF}$ ) Fabric $\mathbf{P}$ strips together end to end. Cut (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 59$ " $(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 149.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ borders. Sew a border strip to each side of the quilt top. From the remaining strip, cut (2) 3 " $x$ $523 / 4$ " $(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 133.99 \mathrm{~cm})$ borders. Sew (1) border to the top and another to the bottom of quilt top.

## Finishing

5. Sew together the (7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ $\times$ WOF) Fabric $\mathbf{R}$ binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
6. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
7. Leaving an 8 " $(20.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
8. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
