

Little Oven Mitts

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Outer Fabric (Pink) - 20" x 10 1/2"
Inner Fabric (Green) - 20" x 10 1/2"
Binding (Pink Leaf) - Fat Quarter
Cotton Batting - 20" x 10 1/2"
Heat Reflective Fleece - 20" x 10 1/2"
Good quality 40 weight cotton thread



Mark quilting lines on inner fabric with chalk, ceramic or disappearing ink pen.

Place outer fabric right side down. Place cotton batting on outer fabric. Place heat reflective fleece shiny side down, towards outer fabric, on cotton batting. Place inner fabric right side up on the fleece.

Pin sandwiched fabrics together and machine stitch along quilting lines. Press flat.

Cut two each of pattern A - Blue outline, B - Pink shaded area and C - Yellow shaded area.

Binding method: Gently fold bias strip in half lengthwise and press flat. Place binding on the back side of the sandwich, matching the raw edges. Pin and stitch 1/4" from raw edge. Press binding over raw edge. Fold binding over to the front side of sandwich covering previous stitch line. Pin and edge stitch. *It helps to use an awl or stitch ripper to hold the edge of the binding in place while stitching.*

Cut 3 - 2 1/2" bias strips. Cut two 5" lengths. Bind the straight edge of each B. Cut two 4" lengths. Bind the straight edge of each C. Cut off excess bias strip.

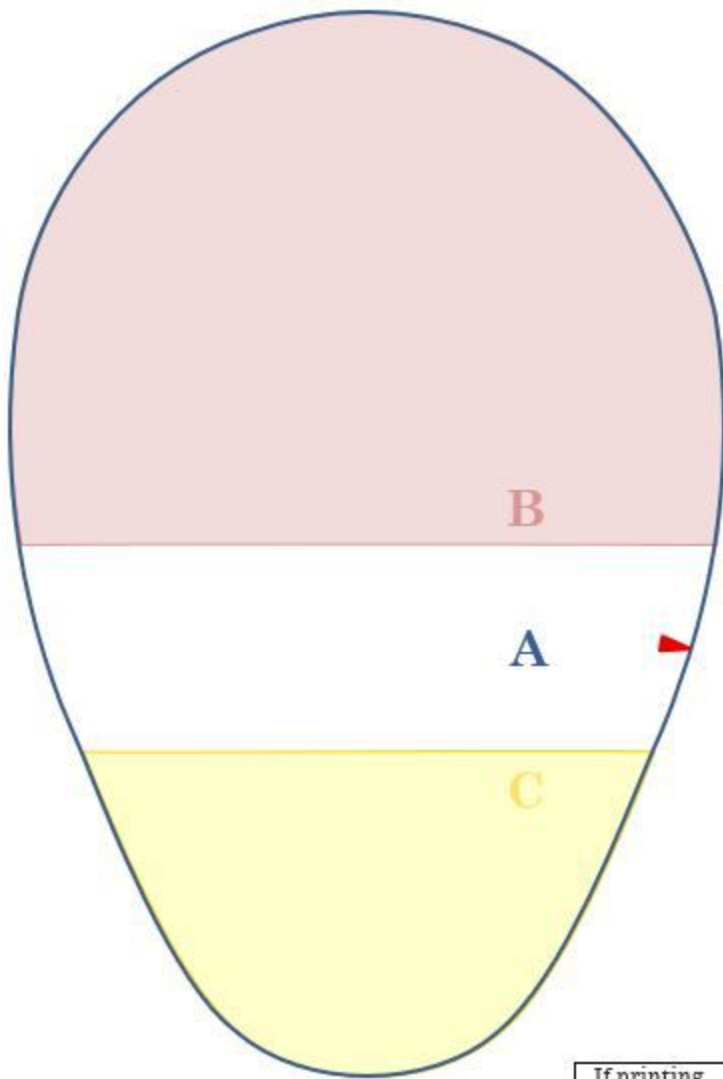
Place B and C on A, inner fabrics together, matching pattern placement. Pin and baste 1/8" from edge. Cut 2 - 21" bias strips. Press one end over 1/4". Place folded end at Red notch and bind, matching the raw edges and easing the binding in at the 1/4" stitching around the curves, and overlapping the end of the binding by 1/2", cutting away the excess binding before folding over. Back stitch the end of the binding. Done!

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When making oven mitts, a layer of cotton batting is recommended as a shield between the outer fabric and the Heat Reflective Fleece (extreme heat will melt fleece and film).
