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MOTORCYCLE SADDLE BAGS

FITMENT INSTRUCTION AND ADVICE TO USERS

THE SADDLE BAG COMES WITH SEMI RIGID PLASTIC SHEET INSERTS .THESE SHOULD BE INSERTED PROPERLY INTO THE FABRIC LOOPS PROVIDED INSIDE THE BAGS TO MAINTAIN THE BAGS SHAPE.PLACE THE SADDLE BAG IN THE SUITABLE POSITION, CLEAR OF MOVING PARTS AND SOURCE OF HEAT.



STEP 1: THE TWO OPPOSED CENTRAL STRAPS SHOULD BE FASTENED TOGETHER AND MOUNTED UNDERNEATH THE SEAT.



STEP 4: PASS THE HEAT SEALED END OF THE ANCHOR WEBBING THROUGH THE WEBBING LOOP (ON THE OTHER END)



STEP 7: PASS THE HEAT SEALED WEBBING END THROUGH THE ELASTIC LOOP. THIS PROCESS SHOULD BE REPEATED UNTILL THE EXTRA WEBBING IS NOT HANGING LOOSE ANY MORE (THIS IS DONE TO AVOID FLAPPING OF THE EXTRA LENGTH OF WEBBING AND MAKING SURE THE WEBBING DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH ANY MOVING PART OF THE MOTORCYCLE)



STEP 2: THEN THE VELCRO STRAPS
PROVIDED SHOULD BE FASTENED
TOGETHER WELL ENOUGH AND MOUNTED
OVER OR UNDER THE SEAT TO ALLOW THE
BEST SECURE FIT TO YOUR MOTORCYCLE.
THE MINIMUM VELCRO OVERLAP SHOULD
BE 16 CMS. MAKE SURE THE SADDLES SIT
TIGHT AGAINST THE SIDE OF THE
MOTORCYCLE AND DO NOT SAG



STEP 5: PULL THE HEAT SEALED END OF THE WEBBING TIGHTLY TO CREAT A SECURE ANCHOR KNOT SYSTEM



STEP 8: PULL THE WEBBING END TO TIGHTEN THE ROLL YOU MADE, THIS SECURES THE LOOP VERY WELL

CAUTION-BY THE END OF STEP 8 NO MORE THEN 2CM OF WEBBING SHOULD BE LEFT LOOSE.

REPEAT STEP 3 TO STEP 8 FOR ALL OTHER ANCHOR KNOT WEBBINGS TO BE PASSED THROUGH OTHER CAM BUCKLES



STEP 3: PASS THE ANCHOR KNOT WEBBINGS THROUGH A DEDICATED LUGGAGE HOOK OR THROUGH A SUITABLE POSITION AVAILABLE ON THE MOTORCYCLE. ONE OPTIONAL WEBBING STRAP WHICH IS TAPER CUT ON BOTH SIDES IS PROVIDED IN CASE THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY OF ATTACHING ANCHOR KNOT WEBBING STRAP AT THE REAR OF THE MOTORCYCLE .PASS ONE END THROUGH THE REAR CAM BUCKLE OF LEFT BAG AND OTHER END THROUGH THE REAR CAM BUCKLE OF THE RIGHT BAG (EXTRA LENGTH OF WEBBING SHOULD BE WRAPPED AROUND THE ELASTIC LOOPS).IN THIS SITUATION YOU ARE ATTACHING THE REAR OF LEFT AND RIGHT BAG TO EACH OTHER INSTEAD OF ATTACHING THEM TO THE MOTORCYCLE. (SECURE THE ANCHOR KNOT OR STRAIGHT WEBBING TO A SPOT WHERE THERE IS NO SLIPAGE AND IT SHOULD BE AWAY FROM MOVING PARTS AND **HEAT SOURCES)**

STEP 6: PASS THE
HEAT SEALED WEBBING
END THROUGH THE
LOWER SIDE OF THE
CAM BUCKLE
(BY PRESSING THE
CAM LEVER). THEN
PULL THE EXTRA
LENGTH OF WEBBING
WHICH IS BEHIND THE



CAM BUCKLE SO BAG IS WELL SECURED



STEP 9: THIS IS HOW THE LUGGAGE SHOULD FIT ON YOUR BIKE

IMPORTANT - LUGGAGE SHOULD BE LOADED EVENLY WITHIN THE STATED MAXIMUM CAPACITY AND WEIGHT LIMITS. DO NOT CARRY SHARP, POINTED OR FLAMMABLE OBJECTS IN THE LUGGAGE. ALWAYS KEEP HEAVY ARTICLES AT THE BOTTOM.

MAKE SURE THE CAM BUCKLES DO NOT TOUCH THE BODY OF THE MOTORCYCLE OR ANY OF ITS PARTS.

BEFORE EVERY RIDE MAKE SURE THAT THE BAG IS SECURED VERY WELL AND ALL WEBBINGS ARE TIGHTLY SECURED.
