

## 2019 Stationery Requirements

### Stationery Required for Every Grade

1. Basics (blue ink pens, coloured ink pens, HB pencils, eraser, sharpener, highlighters, scissors, good quality glue stick, 30cm ruler, punch and stapler); erasable ink pens are not permitted
2. Mathematics set (good quality; Croxley is a suggested brand)
3. USB
4. Exam pads (buy as needed through the year)
5. A4 Graph paper book (to use in Core Mathematics and Sciences)
6. Scientific calculator (Casio *fx-82ZA PLUS* or Casio *fx-991ZA PLUS*)  
(Please note that the Casio *fx-991ZA PLUS* is compulsory for pupils taking Core Mathematics or Advanced Programme Mathematics in Grades 10 to 12. This calculator is available at the School Shop at a specially negotiated price of R390 courtesy of Casio. The Casio *fx-82ZA PLUS* is also available at the School Shop and costs R220.)
7. Dictionaries only required for home use if pupils do not have access to dictionary apps.
8. Padlock for locker (day scholars)
