

1. Aalborg International Composer Competition for classical guitar

Aalborg Guitar Festival and Competitions invites entries for the Composers' Competition for the six-stringed classical guitar. The competition has been arranged in collaboration with Bergmann Edition and with the support of the Augustine Foundation (https://augustinusfonden.dk).

One of the aims of the competition is to promote new work and enlarge the classical guitar repertoire. The intention is that the composer will meet the guitarist, and the guitarist will meet the audience.

Bergmann Edition is the facilitator of the competition and is, therefore, the point of contact.

4. Aalborg International Guitar Competition in two Categories

Conditions of participation in Category I:

- The Aalborg International Guitar Competition is open to classical guitarists of all countries.
- University or Conservatory students or professional players.
- Maximum age of 35 by the start of the competition.
- The competition is in 3 rounds.
- Competitors are offered free accommodation in the period November 16th - 20th as well as catering on November 19th - 20th.
- Conditions Category II:
 - The Competition is open to classical guitarists of all countries
 - Only amateurs between 13 and 17 years of age may take part
 - There is one round only.

The Masterclasses is aimed at skilled guitarists, students at an academy or conservatory and MGK students. All participants receive at least 2 lessons of 50 min and have free acces to all concerts and more. Seminarprice: Kr. 1200 -/€ 160

The "Talent Class" is a course for young people from the ages of 13-18. The course includes ensemble playing, technique exercises, solo lessons etc.

Seminarprice: Kr. 750 -/€ 100

"Classical Guitar 10+" is a course for children who are 9-13 years old and who have played the guitar for 1-2 years and have some knowledge of the guitar fingerboard and technique.

Seminarprice: Kr. 750 -/€ 100

Classical 18+ is a seminar is for beginners, intermediate and advanced guitar players over 18 years of age. The seminar contains solo lessons, technique lessons and guitar ensemble work. Seminarprice: Kr. 1200 -/€ 160
