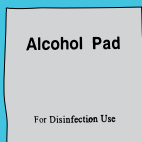

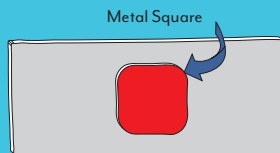
A Alcohol pads



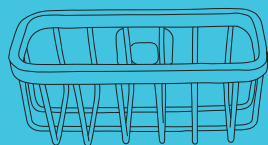
B Drying pads

Q & A

Why do you need a Metal Square?

- Most sinks and even stainless steel sinks will not attract a magnet.
- The rust proof metal square generates attraction of sponge holder.

Why is the Metal Square a square shape?

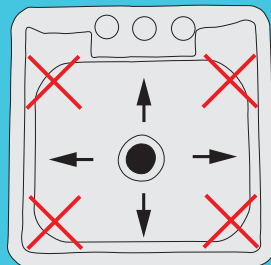
- The shape prevents rotation and slippage of the sponge holder

How do I remove the sponge holder?

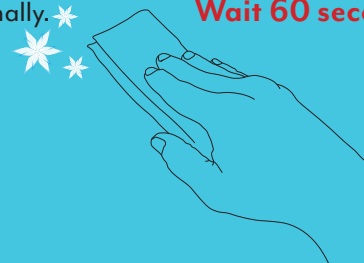
- With a slight outward pull on the sponge holder, it will release so you can fill the sink with all your other goodies.

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** Use the helpful arrows to choose a place in sink to mount the sponge holder. Do not place in red zones (because curve of sink will block placement of sponge holder).

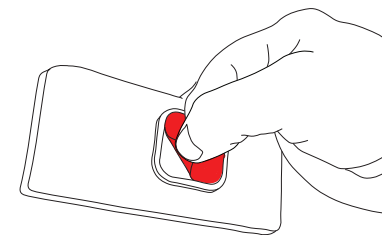


- 2** Clean the area well with the alcohol pad (A), and **DRY** with drying pad (B). It is important for the surface to be completely dry for step 3 and 4 to work optimally. **Wait 60 seconds.**

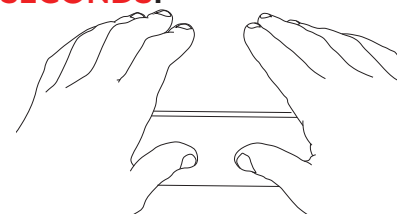


MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

- 3** Peel the red protective film from the adhesive on the back of the provided metal square, which is on the back of the mounting card.

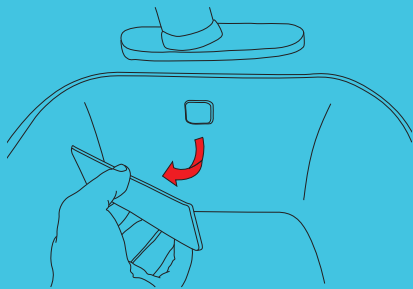


- 4** Now, position mounting card within sink at desired location (**make sure mounting card is level**). Press the finger print on mounting card against the sink, holding it in place for **60 SECONDS.**

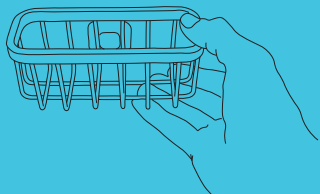


MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

- 5 Wait 24 -72 hours before peeling mounting card off. This allows adhesive to form a strong bond. (Do not place sponge holder on square, yet).



- 6 Remove mounting card and place sponge holder onto the metal square. It should fit on and feel stable with only mild rotation. A gentle pull will allow you to separate the sponge holder from the metal square. Enjoy!



SQUARE REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these instructions to remove the adhesive-backed metal square from your sink:

- 1 Use a spatula or a similar tool to slowly and carefully pry off the metal square. Do not use a sharp tool that could scratch the sink or injure you.
- 2 Use a glue remover to remove any sticky residue that remains. (Goo & Adhesive Remover works well.)
