This beanie is designed with a bit of a slouch and ideal for heads that take up just a bit more space in the world! It's an easy pattern that was designed with a fade in mind, and is perfect for any leftover yarn you want to spin into something fantastic.

## Finished Measurements:

Measures 22 inch circumference
Height: 9 inches

## Gauge:

20 rows and 28 stitches $=4$ rows
In stockinette stitch using larger needles

## Materials:

This pattern calls for 4 color fades.
Yarn used: Spindle Warps Yarns Seattle Sunrise Fade Set in Sparkle Sock Weight
Fiber Content: 70\% Superwash Merino Wool, 20\% Nylon, 10\% Stellina
Knitting Gauge: 7-8 sts $=1$ " on \#1-3 needles ( $2.25 \mathrm{~mm}-3.25 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Yards: 402 yards
Color 1: Midnight (15 Grams)
Color 2: Ferry Ride (15 Grams)

Color 3: One Day At a Time (15 Grams)
Color 4: I See the Light ( 15 Grams)
Suggested Needle Size: Size US 3 ( 2.75 mm ) for Brim and Size 4 ( 3.5 mm ) for Body. Double pointed needles or 16 inch circular needles.

## Abbreviations:

K1 P1: Knit 1 Purl 1
Sts: Stitches
K2tog: Knit 2 together
K1: Knit 1

## Brim:

With smaller needles cast on 144 stitches using Long Tail Method in Color 1. Join in the round trying not to twist any stitches. K1 P1 until brim measures $11 / 2$ inches. Note when switching colors to cut and weave in when finished.

## Body:

Switch to larger needles
Knit 10 rows in color 1
Knit 2 rows in color 2
Knit 2 rows in color 1
Knit 16 rows in color 2
Knit 2 rows in color 3
Knit 2 rows in color 2
Knit 14 rows in color 3
Knit 2 rows in color 4
Knit 2 rows in color 3
Knit 5 rows in color 4

## Hat Decreases

All decreases will be in color 4.

Round 1: Knit
Round 2: *Knit 6, K2tog* repeat to the end of round
Round 3: Knit
Round 4: *Knit 5, K2tog* repeat to the end of round
Round 5: Knit
Round 6: *Knit 4, K2tog* repeat to the end of the round
Round 7: Knit
Round 8: *Knit 3, K2tog* repeat to the end of round
Round 9: Knit
Round 10: *Knit 2, K2tog* repeat to the end of round
Round 11: Knit
Round 12: *Knit 1, K2tog* repeat to the end of the round
Round 13: Knit
Round 14: *Knit 2tog* repeat to the end of the round
Round 15: *Knit 2tog* until 1 st remains, K1
Cut 8 inch tail and weave in ends
You are now done! Enjoy your beanie! ()
