

Ring Size Guide

Before using the ring size guide, make sure it's printed on A4 paper size and scaled to 100%. To confirm this, place a credit card along the diagram below. If the card matches the scale, you're ready to measure.



A - Measure an existing ring

Lay an existing ring that fit's you well on top of one of the circles below. The white circle should match the inside edges of your ring exactly, this means you're ring is placed on the right size. If you're ring fits between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.

B - Measure your finger

Cut out the ruler below following the outline closely. Make a small cut along the dotted line to create a slit in the paper. Wrap the ruler around your finger, and slide the thin end through the slit. We recommend selecting a size that goes on and off your finger comfortably.

Ring size may vary depending on style of ring.
