Walk Route Description

Flat plateau of Berry Head National Nature Reserve. Most of this route is level and on surfaced paths suitable for wheelchair users and pushchairs, and a mobilty scooter.

Route

- Exit the Car Park (Start Point) and take the path leading off to the right towards the cliffs.
- From the viewpoint turn right to take the path leading up the ramparts and into the Southern Fort.
- Retrace your steps back to the car park, and when you reach the main tarmac track, turn right and follow it out towards the headland.
- Continue out along the track to the lighthouse.
- From the lighthouse retrace your steps back out of the fort to where the track splits, turn right.
- Continue for approximately 100 metres and take the path leading off to the left.
- Continue along the access path, returning to the Car park (Start Point).
