Walk Route Description

This is a short circular walk which circumnavigates a part of the Ellis Reading Wood and takes in Marian's Inclosure, which meanders through the beautiful Oakland woods and other interesting aspects of the forest. Some parts of the walk can be muddy in wet weather so sturdy foot wear is recommended.

Note: Due to the nature of the area, there will be some slopes to walk up or down making the walks unsuitable for most pushchairs and wheelchairs.

Forestry Commission information leaflets on other walks in the immediate area are available from the reception of the Forest Holidays site.

Route

- From the Forest Holidays Site Car Park turn left onto Broom Hill.
- Follow the road until you reach the farm buildings on your right and before reaching the Bracelands Campsite.
- Thirty meters past the farm buildings turn left and enter the forest.
- Follow the track throughout your walk.
- The track, which circumnavigates the Marian's Inclosure, will eventually bring you out of the forest at the southern point of the Forest Holidays site and back to your start point.
