Little Haven Circular Walk

Region - Pembrokeshire

County/Area - Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

Length – 2.2 miles / 3.6 kms

Duration – 1 hour

Ascent - Cliff edge, rugged coast, quiet country lane, open fields and minor road

Grade – Easy/Moderate

Start - Car Park (near St. Brides Inn)

Postcode SA62 3UN (approx. location only)

Walk Route Description

Little Haven can be very busy in summer but outside the village the paths and lanes make for quiet walking. During spring and early summer the lane verges of west Pembrokeshire are a particular joy with a huge variety of wildflowers including red campion, cow parsley and foxgloves. The cliffs are spectacular on this stretch of the coast (250 feet) with great views.

Route

- From the start point (car park) walk North to Grove Place.
- At the junction turn right and continue to Wesley Road.
- Follow Wesley Road for approx. 150m joining the footpath.
- Follow the footpath through wooded and open fields for approximately 750m joining the farm track.
- Turn right and West and follow the track for approx. 800m reaching Woodlands Farm
- Pass the farm and turn right and North onto the footpath through the woods for approximately 500m reaching Strawberry Place.
- At the junction with Strawberry Hill turn left onto the road and continue South for approximately 500 m. Take the left hand fork located at the North end of the Howelston Holiday Park and join the Pembrokeshire Coastal Path.
- Turn right and follow the Coastal Path for approx. 1.2km until you reach Point Road.
- At Point Road turn right and continue for approx. 100m to the junction of St. Brides Road.
- At the junction turn right onto St. Brides Road, passing the St. Brides Inn on your left and reenter the Car Park (Start point).
