

Mailscot Wood Trail

Region – Wye Valley/Forest of Dean

County/Area – Symonds Yat/Mailscot

Walk Route Description

A hilly walk with panoramic views over the River Wye. The walk starts at the edge of the ancient hill fort built 2,500 years ago. Signposted just off the trail, not far from the start, is a fantastic viewpoint overlooking the village of Symonds Yat West and the river Wye rapids. Be aware that the walk has some steep hilly sections, as well as some muddy areas, so good footwear is essential.

The Mailscot trail is very well sign posted throughout by Pink and white Trail Markers.

Additional Forestry Commission information of the route is available from the Log Cabin Café at the start of the walk.
