

Porthgain Circular Walk

Region – Pembrokeshire

County/Area – Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

Length – 3.6 miles / 5.8 kms

Duration – 2hours

Ascent – Cliff edge, open fields and steep descent to Porthgain

Grade – Moderate

Start – Car Park by Porthgain Harbour

Postcode SA62 5BL (approx. location only)

Walk Route Description

This walk consists of a 2.7km section of the Porthgain, Pembrokeshire Coastal Path and turns inland passing through open fields on your homeward journey. The cliffs and waters around Porthgain provide a rich variety of habitats for animal, plant and marine life.

Route

- From the Harbour Car Park (Start Point), walk North joining the Pembrokeshire Coastal Path.
- Follow the path, overlooking the ragged coastline to your right, for approximately 2.7kms.
- Follow the path West to the Abereidis Blue Lagoon.
- After passing the Blue Lagoon follow the path right and East following the track through open fields for approximately 1.7kms, keeping the woods to your right, continue to Ynys Barry Holiday Cottages.
- Continue East past the holiday cottages for approximately 400m and join the Llanrhian Road.
- At the junction turn left and North and continue along the road to Porthgavin, returning to your start point.
