

Stackpole Head Circular Walk

Region – Pembrokeshire

County/Area – Pembrokeshire Coast National Park

Length – 4.9 miles/7.9 kms

Duration – 2hours 30 minutes

Ascent – Rugged Coast, stiles and open fields.

Grade –Easy/ Moderate

Start – Quay – Stackpole Harbour.

Postcode SA71 5LS (approx. location only)

Walk Route Description

This route includes a 3km section of the Pembrokeshire Coastal Path and continues inland along a section Bosherton Lily ponds and open fields of Stackpole Park. The limestone cliffs on and around Stackpole Head (between Broad Haven South and Barafundle Bay) are spectacular. The sea has sculpted stacks, caves, arches, inlets and headlands,

Route

- From the Car Park (Start Point), join the coastal path continuing South to Barafundle Bay Beach.
- Continue south along the coastal path to Stackpole Head.
- Continue along the coastal path to Broadhaven beach, overlooking Church Rock.
- At this point, leave the coastal path and walk North and follow the path, keeping the ponds to your left.
- Cross the foot bridge and continue North through the woodlands and keeping the ponds to your right.
- At Fish Pond, re-cross the pond via the bridge and continue East on the path passing through open fields of Stackpole Park, returning to the car park and the Start point.
