Scheduling

Verbose Camp Counselor (Day Camp) - Job Description

Verbose Language Learning Camp is seeking a creative and outgoing day camp counselors to join our new summer camp. In this position, you will play a key role in shaping and educating our campers by instructing them during numerous Spanish language learning activities and experiences.

Duties:

You will collaborate with the program director and other counselors to create educational, cultural, social and recreational activities, and lead campers in fun-filled projects. The **Camp Counselor** is responsible for leadership and implementation of core and non-core programs and experiences for children in a small group setting. As well as responsible for the general safety and development, growth, and skill achievement of the participants in his/her group. The counselor will provide high quality indoor and outdoor educational and recreational experiences for participants that focus on the Verbose core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Learn and implement a weekly schedule for your camp group.
- Organize and lead a variety of small and large group activities each week. Activities may include crafts, nature, songs, games, swimming, etc.
- Identify and respond to camper behavior issues.
- Ensure that the classroom is kept clean, organized, and free of litter.
- Communicate with parents about participant's experiences and report concerns to Camp Leadership.
- Assist in maintaining accurate program records including incident reports, logbook documentation, and daily attendance.
- Know and understand ALL emergency procedures associated with the camp program.
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp and all program areas. This includes but is not limited to being responsible for your campers' safety and their whereabouts at all times.
- Assist Program Director and Camp Volunteers where ever possible.
- Maintain constant surveillance, know and review all emergency procedures and respond to emergency situations immediately. Attend all in-service trainings.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Qualifications:

- Upon hire, complete orientation and training provided including First Aid and Basic Life Support certification.
- Education, training or experience in camp, youth programs, recreation, working with children, or in a related field.
- Ability to lead, plan, organize, and implement program activities.
- Ability to work as a member of a team and the ability to accomplish tasks with little direct supervision.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- **Spanish Language proficiency and or fluency.**

Preferred Qualifications:

We are looking for someone who is dependable, responsible, and positive. Preferably some previous experience working with children. We ask that this person of at least their high school diploma and have a driver's license. Experience working with youth is a big plus.

Work Conditions:

- Must have the physical ability to lead and participate in camp activities which include, but are not limited to; team building initiatives, physical games, and learning activities.
- Must be capable of carrying loads of up to 90 pounds without undue exertion.
- Perform essential program support to camp activities and programs which may include, but not limited to the following activities: semi – reaching to full-reach overhead, crouching, kneeling, twisting of the waist, shoulders, and legs, and lying on stomach and/or back.
- Must have the ability to physically manage and support children when needed for safety in general camp activities (child weighing 50 - 150 pounds).
- Ability to perform a variety of tasks outdoor in different climate.
- If applicable, hear noises and distress signals anywhere around the zone of responsibility, with or without reasonable accommodation.
- If applicable, remain alert with no lapses of consciousness.
- If applicable, see and observe all sections of an assigned zone of responsibility, with or without reasonable accommodation.
