What I like

POSITION



Bright indirect light will keep my foliage looking its satiny best and me at my happiest. If you throw me a bit of shade I can handle it but I may eventually lose my variegation!

TEMPERATURE



I run hot! I prefer temperatures above 15°C and it goes without saying, I can't handle frost. I also like it as humid as you can provide!

WATER



Wait until the top 2-3 cm of soil in my pot have dried out then give me a good drink, let me dry out a bit more in the colder months. Don't let me sit in water! If my leaves start to yellow I've been drinking too much!

FERTILIZER



A good pinch of slow release indoor plant fertilizer in spring is all I need.

RE-POTTING



Repot me in spring when I outgrow my pot. Don't increase my pot size too much as it will hold too much water and I'm susceptible to the drink! A good quality general potting mix is all I need, I'm very easy.

What I don't like

COLD DRAFTS & SOGGY SOIL



You should prune me occasionally it will make me a more well rounded individual!

I'm not about cold drafts and soggy soil...hate them! If the tips of my leaves are looking a bit brown then I'm probably not getting enough humidity.
