## Why care?

These are the issues that result from tenants without suitable flooring...

Lack of suitable flooring in social housing is a key issue for Housing Associations, resulting in additional support to tenants and increased tenancy turnover





1 in 2 of tenants who do not have suitable flooring say it has affected their children's health and wellbeing by not being able to play on the floor



New flooring is expensive

Tenants also state that not having suitable flooring resulted in physical, mental and psychological affects including depression, breathing difficulties and arthritis

Not being able to invite friends and visitors into their home increases isolation and loneliness



Lack of flooring increases fuel bills at a time when they are at their highest

Lack of flooring increases noise, resulting in neighbour disputes 53

High risk to children crawling on concrete and hard wood floors

### Why care about carpet?



Carpet absorbs ten times more airborne noise than any other flooring material<sup>1</sup>



tonnes are sent to landfill in the UK annually, most of it nowhere near the end of its working life<sup>2</sup>

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The National Safety **Council reports that** falls cause most indoor injuries. Carpets reduce the incidence of slips and falls. It also cushions falls and prevents serious injury<sup>1</sup>

On average, children whose bedrooms were carpeted needed lower rates of asthma medication and missed fewer days of school due to asthma attacks<sup>3</sup>

The average airborne fine dust concentration in indoor rooms equipped with hard flooring material is much higher than in indoor rooms covered with wall-to-wall carpet<sup>4</sup>

A carpeted room promotes thermal comfort, saves energy and also contributes to a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions that are a major cause of climate change<sup>5</sup>

### Case study Newport City Homes

Greenstream Flooring CIC first started working with Newport City Homes in May 2019 and despite a lull in operations during Covid-19, Greenstream Flooring CIC continued to operate a supply and fit service to NCH, with Covid-19 precautions in place, throughout this period.

Since May 2019, Newport City Homes has supported over 100 separate households with up to three rooms of carpet (repurposed commercial carpet tiles). Greenstream Flooring CIC has a set price for up to three rooms supplied and/or fitted for two rooms plus stairs and landing (new broadloom and underlay) per property so that Newport City Homes can budget effectively.





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"We use our hardship fund to support as many tenants as we can to access carpet, they otherwise would be unable to afford. Our expectations of Greenstream Flooring CIC is that, based on our measurements, they supply and fit repurposed carpet tiles to our properties, when requested. They know our budget constraints so we find that by fitting repurposed carpet tiles, opposed to new carpet, our budget per property can go so much further and of course our tenants are really happy to have carpets, they otherwise wouldn't have." **Sarah Burt, Housing Manager, Newport City Homes.**
