- 2. Additional fees? Parking, Food, Air fills etc. Incidental cash. Tips.
- 3. Waivers signed? Medical History form? Doctors Approval before Ocean. Overall health?
- 4. Schedule and logistics planning. (Your instructor will give you the info)



- Good attitude! Patience and Safety are key. Your Motivation for Learning?
- Tell us why you want to scuba dive. Are you planning a trip?
- Save the Celebration Party until class is over. Oversleeping and Hangover / Seasickness are the number one reasons why students don't pass the scuba class!
- Go to Bed Early the night before your Water Training. Being fashionably late will earn you expensive make up fees. Be at the Dive Site at the Prescribed Time Please.
- Treat boat tickets like airline tickets. If you miss the flight/boat, you buy another ticket.
- Average to good swimming ability and Watermanship skills. If you are out of shape, Uncomfortable in the water, or Claustrophobic, you will need additional water training. The additional water training is at the discretion of the instructor and is only for your safety. Training is available as private or group. If you need group training, it is cheaper, but private training may be more desirable if you need personal attention. Private Aquatic Sessions are \$350.00 including the rental equipment and are payable to Hollywood Divers.

Certification agreement

- I promise to show up to my sessions on time, with a clear head and all required equipment in hand. I understand that the instructor is not responsible for training me if I am Hungover, missing required gear or late. Private Make up sessions of dives are billable at \$125.00 per hour (min 2.5hrs) payable to Hollywood Divers.
- 2. If I forget any required gear and rent it at the dive site, these fees are not covered by Hollywood Divers. It is not the Instructors duty to bring extra gear to the site.
- 3. Hollywood Divers Rentals are subject to rinse fees (\$20 per item) and late fees. Please bring your rentals back no later than two days after your class finishes. Clean. No Sand or Dirt. No Smell. Wet is okay. Thanks.
- 4. Please take precautions against Rental gear theft. If the Rental gear is lost or stolen, I am responsible for gear replacement fees. _____
- 5. I promise not to use the gear without supervision of my scuba instructor.
- 6. I understand this class is a group class and I should make every effort to be suited up and prepared to dive when the majority of the class agrees to be suited up.
- 7. I understand that weather is unpredictable and the instructor or boat captain has final discretion over diving activities. If conditions are deemed unsafe, it is for your protection and a make up day will need to be scheduled with the group.
- 8. I understand I am not paying for a certification card. I will be evaluated on academic, pool and open water skills. Even though I attend and pay for all segments of training a certification is not guaranteed. I must pass the class with a level of comfort in the water.
- 9. I will prepare before the pool session by Inhaling through my snorkel / Mouth and Exhaling through my nose while my face is submerged in water, with NO mask . Sink or bathtub ok.
