Logitech's audio division continues to impress with its range of weatherproof Bluetooth speakers that sound infinitely more grown-up than their eyeball-searing colours would suggest. WONDERBOOM is a fist-sized speaker that has been drop-tested to 1.5m and, as well as having the capacity to float, comes with an equally pool-perfect IPX7 rating – meaning it will survive being dunked in water for up to 30 minutes.
