Are BrightSign Series 4 models reaching end-of-life?	Production has ended on series 4 models except for the XT1144 which will continue to be available for 2023. We will continue to fully support all Series 4 models now and into the future just as we do with our Series 3 models.

What is the compatibility of Series 5 players with our software & network management services?	All available BrightSign Series 5 players are currently supported in BSN.cloud, BrightAuthor:connected, BrightAuthor, BrightSign Network and BrightSign Network Enterprise Edition. The only exception is that AU335 is not supported with BrightSign Network & BrightAuthor.	
What are the localization plans for BrightAuthor:connected/BSN.cloud?	Currently the following languages are supported: English, Spanish, German, Italian, French, Japanese & Chinese. Any new release made available going forward will automatically be localized for all these languages.	
What BrightSign OS do Series 5 players run?	Support for Series 5 players begins in BrightSign OS 9.	
What BrightSign Wi-Fi Module is supported on Series 5?	Only the WD-105 is supported on Series 5 players which has an MSRP of \$75. The WD-104 and WD-105 are the same dual-antenna Wi-Fi module technology, but the kitting is different because the installation method is different from Series 5 to Series 4.  Technically it is the same solution but physically they are different. A WD-104 will not fit on a Series 5 player and a WD-105 will not fit on a Series 4 player.
