1.Opening remarks: welcome members and non-members! We have quorum. Welcome to new principal, Natalie Maurice. She introduced herself, reported that Mrs Brayne had filled her in, reported that she was excited to work with us, and that she was available for meetings. 4. Business arising from May minutes:

- -Update on ice cream truck: All set for Friday, June 18th. Flavors discussed. 11 flavors (including non-dairy, sorbet, and vegan). There is also a Mr Freeze option. Parents were given option to say if they were declining the treat. Mrs Brayne would like him to come at 11:30 to make sure everyone gets their ice cream. He should park on the side of the school. Staff should also get ice cream.
- -Birdhouses: Should be finished painting tomorrow. Received names of 33 community members interested in getting birdhouses. Mme Lafrance has offered to deliver them. Some parents (4) are interested in helping with delivery and volunteered.
- -\$100 spent on Chapters Gift Cards for climate action week. Mrs Brayne sent in many pictures by video and took photos to send in from the school. City brought 5 kits of reusable bags and hats for the kids. Mrs Brayne will have a draw.
- -Tulips: \$60 spent on white tulip bulbs and will arrive in the fall. Will need a plan to fix the flag because Gabrielle no longer has the grid and some tulips have been displaced.
- -School photo: Catherine has asked Lifetouch to make a mosaic this year again. 8x10 and will be in a black frame.
- Open positions for coordinators and executive: Some nominations are in for President (Catherine Fini), VP Communication (Krista Gendron), Secretary (), Treasurer (Neil Linsdell). Coordinators need to be filled: Book Fair, Staff Appreciation, New Parent Info night, Grad, Art Gala, Ice Wall. Parents' night is first Thursday when kids are back in September.

5.1President's Report (including QFHSA).

QFHSA AGM (Catherine)

8 resolutions were voted on in favor. Voted in members as well. These resolutions are to be sent to Ministry of Education. Heidi Yetman (guest speaker) addressed teacher shortage (less salary here than in the rest of the country and working conditions), spoke to negotiations going on, discussed mental health of teachers (67% said they were concerned about their mental health this year). Suggested that as a H&S, we can support staff by reaching out to school boards to ask what they are doing to support staff.

- -AGM is September 20th at 7 pm. Nominations still open and will stay open until AGM.
- -Reminder about filing in updates as committee coordinators
- -QFHSA awards were delivered.

5.2Treasurer's Report & Budget (Neil)

- -Not many changes since last month. A few expenses were paid for: Grad, orders for clothing sales. We have over \$2200 that are flexible that we can re-allocate as unspent for the year.
- -Mrs Brayne asked about Jungle Sport as Mrs Maurice was also interested. 5 days of Jungle Sport can be \$4100-\$4500. How much is H&S willing to contribute? We did 4 days last time. We suggested making the commitment to Jungle Sport now, Neil recommended \$2000-\$3000 for the activity.
- -Catherine spoke to pink shirts: \$6.00 shirts if we get 300 shirts Total cost would be \$1800. We discussed if we want to give shirts to everyone or have families pay for it. Pink shirts can be worn all year. Motion to approve purchasing pink t-shirts for anti-bullying for everyone next year. Motion: Tracey, Seconded by Marcia. All in favor.
