

<u>FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ECC0099R RHS CLUTCH CASE COVER</u> TRIUMPH STREET TRIPLE/STREET TRIPLE R AND DAYTONA 675/675R



In this kit there should be:

1 x Engine Case Cover (ECC0099R) 3 x M6x35mm long cap head bolt 1 x Racing Puck (SK0001SK (already fitted)) 2 x PAL Nuts (already fitted)

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS FULLY BEFORE STARTING

- Please make sure the engine is cold before proceeding with the fitting of the R&G cover.
- On the Daytona models you will have to remove two top fairing bolts and gently ease the middle panel away from bike to allow fitment of the engine case cover.
- Remove oil filler cap.
- Remove the three engine case bolts arrowed above (please note there is a sealing washer on the bolt marked 'A'). Hold the cover loosely over the case to help identify the correct ones. DO NOT REMOVE ALL OF THE CASE BOLTS.
- Remove the sealing washer from the original bolt.
- Place one of the bolts with a washer through the engine case cover in position arrowed 'A' and place the sealing washer over exposed end of bolt (so it is between spacer and engine case).

- Offer up the R&G cover to the engine and carefully fit it over the engine casing. Ensure that the three R&G bolt holes are lined up with the holes in the engine casing, and then push on as far as it will go.
- With a 5mm Allen key tighten the bolts with washers equally so that they pull the cover into place. DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.
- Finally use a torque wrench set at 10 nm (7 Lb ft) to fully tighten.
- On the Daytona models refit fairing bolts and relocate middle fairing on push grommet.
- Refit oil filler cap.
- It is suggested that you check the tightness of the mounting bolts on a regular basis i.e. when cleaning or once a month.
- NOTE for the cleaning of this product you should only use a soft polishing cloth and a mild general cleaning agent
- AVOID HARMFUL CHEMICALS IF IN DOUBT DO NOT USE AS THEY COULD ALTER THE STRENGTH OF THE COVER.
- R&G will accept no liability if the above procedure and torque settings are not followed.

FRANCE INSTRUCTIONS DE MONTAGE ECC0099R RHS Côté droit TRIUMPH STREET TRIPLE/STREET TRIPLE R et DAYTONA 675/675R



Ce kit contient: 1 x Protection moteur (ECC0099R) 3 x Vis M6x35 mm

MERCI DE LIRE LA NOTICE AVANT DE COMMENCER LE MONTAGE

- Veiller à ce que le moteur de la moto soit froid
- Sur les modèles Daytona, vous devrez enlever 2 boulons de carénage du haut et retirez délicatement la partie du milieu pour permettre le montage du carter moteur.
- Enlever le capuchon de remplissage d'huile.
- Enlever les 3 vis de fixation du carter moteur (voir photo ci-dessus). A noter que la vis marquée « A » sur la photo a une rondelle d'étanchéité. Ne pas retirer toutes les vis de fixations de carter.
- Enlever la bague d'étanchéité de la vis « A ».
- Glisser une vis avec une rondelle dans le trou inférieur de la protection et placer la bague d'étanchéité entre la rondelle d'origine et la protection R&G.
- Placer la protection sur le carter (attention au sens de montage-)

- Vérifier que les trous et les filetages de fixation soient bien alignés. Et pousser le cache sur le moteur.
- Visser légèrement les 3 vis dans le carter moteur (attention à ne pas mettre les vis de travers, nous vous conseillons de les visser à la main dans un premier temps).
- A l'aide d'une clé Allen de 5 mm, visser les vis avec rondelles, ne pas bloquer les vis pour le moment
- A l'aide d'une clé dynamométrique, serrer les 3 vis, (couple de serrage 10 Nm/7Lb ft)
- Sur les modèles Daytona, remettre les boulons du carénage et remplacer le carénage du milieu en protégeant les œillets.
- Replacer le capuchon de remplissage d'huile
- Note importante:
 - -vérifier le serrage des vis au moins une fois par mois.
 - -Le nettoyage de la protection, doit se faire à l'aide d'un produit nettoyant non agressif et à l'aide d'un chiffon doux.
- L'UTILISATION D'AGENT NETTOYANT TROP PUISSANT PEUT ALTERER LA FINITION DE VOTRE PROTECTION R&G.
