



How to install Adjustments

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Loosen and remove the cover underneath the lower triple clamp.

3

Remove the covers indicated in the figure. Loosen the ECU, do not remove.

4

Disconnect the original steering damper cable. Remove the original steering damper with cable.

5

Connect the resistor, provided in this kit, to the original wiring harness. Fasten the resistor to the cooling fan bracket, use tie rap provided in this kit.

6

Install the Öhlins steering damper to the bracket assembly (02230-10). Install it according to the figure.

7

Install the steering damper to the frame using the original screw and washers.

8

Fasten the end eye to the original triple clamp bracket. use screw/spacer (02274-03), nut (00430-05) and screw (01046-01) provided in this kit.

9

Loosen the screws to bracket assembly (02230-10) in step 4. Adjust the steering damper by letting it slide in its bracket assembly so that the steering damper uses similar stroke both ways.

Note!

Make sure that the steering has clearance for turning both to the left and to the right end positions, and that the damper is not used as a stop.


Reinstall all standard covers.

Caution

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the steering damper.
