

Chapstick Keychain

Use 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise indicated.

Get creative with embroidery stitches across the top tab but practice first on scrap fabric.

Cut the sections out of oaktag or light cardboard to make fabric cutting faster.

- 1. Cut a 4" x 6" scrap of fabric. Cut 3" x 3" piece for the tab.
- **2.** Fold 3x3 tab piece WST and press. Open the fold and fold each side into the middle and press again. Fold and press again. Edgestitch down each side of the tab. Set aside.
- **3.** Fold the 4x6 piece in half lengthwise RST. Sew down the length with 1/4" SA. Turn right side out and press.
- **4.** Tuck one end in on itself 1/4". Fold the tab piece in half an insert into the tucked end and pin to hold in place.
- **5.** Fold up the bottom edge 1/4" and then fold up again 1" below the top edge. This creates the pocket for the lip balm.
- 6. Start sewing with an edgestitch from the bottom corner toward the top. Turn the corner and sew over the tab and the tucked top. Reverse over the tab section to reinforce it (optional).
- **7.** Run the tab through the split ring and add the lip balm.
