

Sew Outside the Box 9

Reversible Headband Pattern

Required Supplies

Fabric Pattern Plastic Headband

Thread Interfacing Needle for hand sewing

Safety Pin

1. Print and cut the pattern.



2. Choose two different scrap fabrics to make the headband reversible. Cut each fabric on the fold according to the pattern.



- 3. Fuse the interfacing to the wrong side of each fabric.
- 4. Place fabrics RST and sew along each side with a 1/4" seam allowance. Leave a longer opening toward the end of one side. The longer opening gives room for tucking and hand sewing.



- 5. Trim the seam allowance to 1/8". Use the safety pin to turn the headband right side out.
 - 6. Tuck the smallest opening end and edgestitch three sides.



- 7. Insert the plastic headband. Fold the side opening and short edge 1/4" and press carefully. Keep the hot iron away from the plastic headband.
- 8. Hand sew the opening closed with a running stitch.
