Instructions

- 1. Print the pattern page and measure the 1" test square to ensure printing is to scale. Print with Adobe Acrobat for best results. Printer should be set at 100%.
- 2. Trace the applique pieces onto freezer paper. Rough cut around the shapes. Attach shapes to the wool (shiny side down) and adhere with hot iron. Cut carefully around the shapes.
- 3. Blanket stitch the jelly to the front fabric. Use applique pins to hold the shapes in place.
- 4. Whip stitch the front wool to the back wool.
- 5. Use fusible to attach the flannel back to the back wool. Press with a hot iron. Slide the needle between the wool and the fusible and blanket stitch both together.
- 6. Give a final long press on the back and trim the threads.

I do my best to make correct patterns, however; errors do sometimes occur. Please notify me if you find an error in the pattern or instructions.
