SunBonnet Sue Mug Rug Instructions and Pattern

Materials

Main Fabric 7" x 10"

Backing Fabric 9" x 12"

Double-sided fusible 7" x 10"

Fabric scraps

Fusible web

Fusible tape (optional)

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Instructions

- 1. Print the pattern page and measure the test square to ensure the printer is printing correctly. Use actual size and print from Adobe Acrobat for best results.
- 2. Cut main fabric and apply double-sided fusible to the main fabric. Leave the backing fabric off for now. Mark a rectangle 6" x 9" on the main fabric. Set aside.
- 3. Trace shapes onto fusible and rough cut around. Apply shapes to back side of fabric scraps and then carefully cut around.
- 4. Add the shapes to the main fabric and use a hot iron to fuse. Stitch around the shapes.
- 5. Trim the main fabric and fusible to 6" x 9".
- 6. Fuse the wrong side of the backing fabric to the main section.
- 7. Trim the backing fabric to one inch around the main. Fold the backing fabric in half so the raw edge meets the fusible. Press to make a crease. Do this on all four sides.
- 8. Fold the fabric over to the main fabric and hold in place with fusible tape or clips or pins. Make 90 degree angles at the corner folds.
- 9. Stitch the binding in place at the very edge of the binding to hold it in place.

I do my best to make correct patterns, however; errors do sometimes occur. Please notify me if you find an error in the pattern or instructions.
