Paintings by Welsh artist Sarah Jane Brown feature at art exhibition celebrating International Women's Day in Cardiff

Contemporary landscape painter Sarah Jane Brown is showing a series of landscape paintings at Off The Wall Gallery's latest exhibition celebrating International Women's Day in March. This mixed media all-female art exhibition "An equal world is an enabled world" launched on 7th March and features Sarah Jane's recent paintings alongside the work of other talented contemporary female artists.

The "An equal world is an enabled world" art exhibition celebrates International Women's Day on 8th March, a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women, and their new 2020 campaign #EachForEqual which runs all year and originates from a sense of collective individualism. The #EachForEqual campaign recognises that we are all parts of a whole, and that our individual actions, conversations, behaviours and mindsets can have an impact on our larger society. Collectively, we can make change happen, and collectively, we can each help to create a gender equal world.

Through painting Sarah Jane explores her relationship with her immediate environment, using the landscape metaphorically to examine more emotional concerns. Sarah Jane's natural ability to convey the intensity of her experiences presents an emotional narrative throughout her work, encouraging viewers to connect and engage on a deeper level.

Situated in The Old Probate Registry, a beautifully refined Victorian building in Llandaff, Cardiff, Off The Wall Gallery provides a calm and peaceful space to view Sarah Jane's landscape paintings. An Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK, with a forthcoming solo show due to take place at Picton Castle, Pembrokeshire in July, and has recently enjoyed several international exhibitions. Current paintings can also be seen at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, Oriel Coffi in Llanidloes and the Russell Gallery in Putney. Notable highlights include exhibiting with the Royal Society of Marine Artists at London's Mall Galleries and the Royal Cambrian Academy in North Wales.
