Pembrokeshire artist Sarah Jane Brown exhibiting landscape paintings at museum art exhibition in Spain

Contemporary Welsh artist Sarah Jane Brown is exhibiting paintings in 'Ephemeral Landscapes', a new art exhibition taking place at Museo Gustavo de Maeztu in Navarra, Spain. This group show opened on Saturday 5th October and features paintings by various international artists. Two of Sarah Jane's evocative landscape paintings 'The firefly awakens' and 'Be lost in me' were selected for the exhibition, and will be available to view at Museo Gustavo de Maeztu until 17th November.

Through painting Sarah Jane explores her relationship with her immediate environment, using the landscape metaphorically to examine more emotional concerns. Sarah Jane's natural ability to convey the intensity of her experiences presents an emotional narrative throughout her work, encouraging viewers to connect and engage on a deeper level.

Combining a mix of 'old master' and contemporary techniques, Sarah Jane's rich expressive style uses a variety of methods; staining, glazing and blending in many layers, gradually building up thickness and texture. Paint is applied with brushes, knives, rags and sometimes fingers. It is painted, scraped, flicked, spattered and poured on, and sometimes off again, until the finished painting presents itself.

An Associate Member of the Guild Society of Artists (AGSA), Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK and recently enjoyed several international exhibitions. Notable highlights include exhibiting with the Royal Society of Marine Artists at London's Mall Galleries and the Royal Cambrian Academy in North Wales. Sarah Jane has also recently been invited to become a member of the Fine Art Trade Guild Committee.

Upcoming UK exhibitions include solo show Shifting Edges at Off The Wall Gallery in Cardiff from 19th October until 16th November, and solo exhibition at Picton Castle, Pembrokeshire in 2020. Sarah Jane's work can be also viewed at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, Pembrokeshire, Oriel Coffi in Llanidloes, Powys, Off The Wall Gallery in Llandaff, Cardiff and the Russell Gallery in Putney, London.
