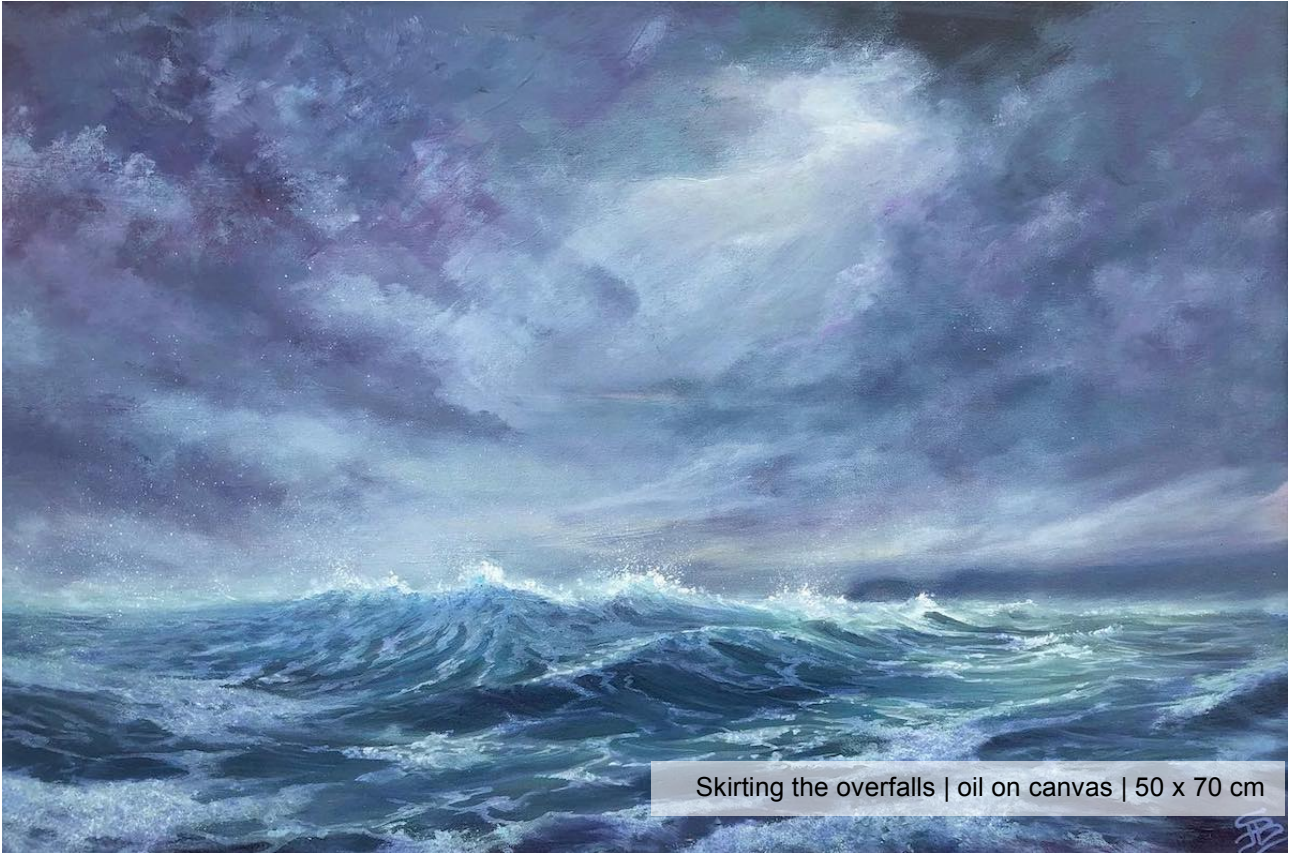


## Pembrokeshire artist Sarah Jane Brown to exhibit paintings at London's annual Welsh cultural event

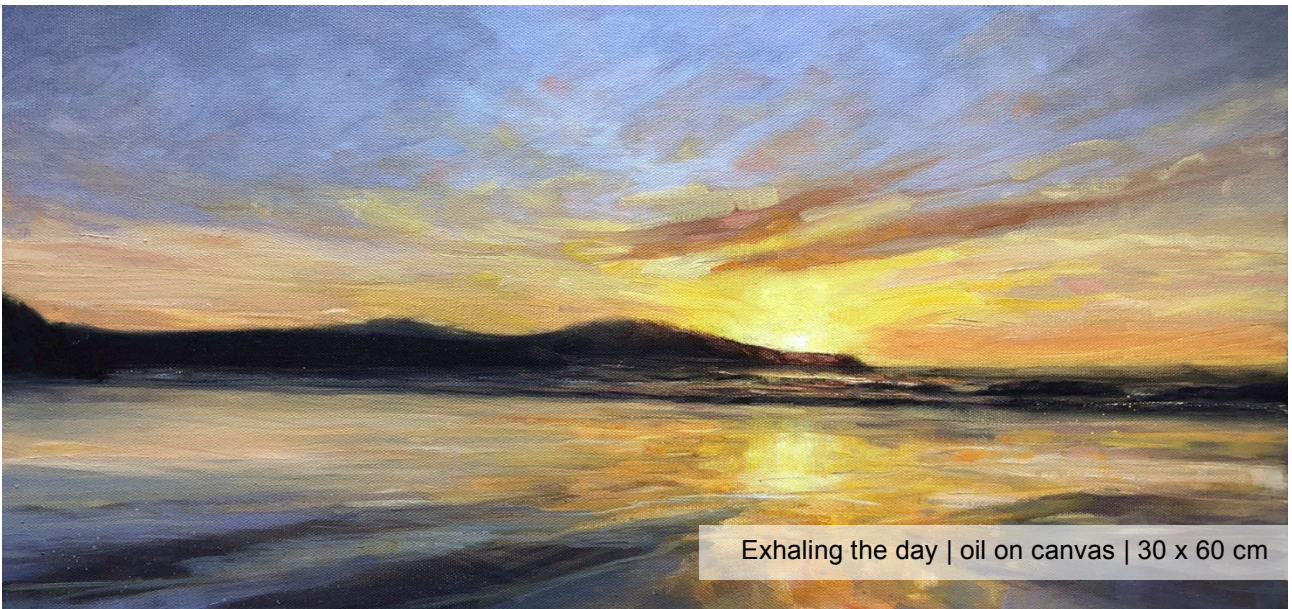
