
Welsh artist Sarah Jane Brown to feature in the Guild Artists Exhibition 2018 in Stratford-upon-Avon and London in May

After recently being welcomed as an Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, contemporary landscape painter Sarah Jane Brown has had three of her paintings accepted to feature in the annual Guild Artists Exhibition in Stratford-upon-Avon and London in May.

The exhibition begins with a public preview at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Stratford-upon-Avon on 12th May 12-5pm, followed by a drinks reception 6-11pm, before moving to London for the main exhibition at the Guild Gallery from 22-28 May 2018, open 10-5pm. Sarah Jane's three original oil paintings 'A sense of purpose', 'Speaking Clearly' and 'Instrument of Change' will be on display and available to purchase at both venues, and also available as high quality reproduction prints, each in an exclusive limited edition of just ten.

The Guild Society of Artists will select a painting from this year's Guild Artists Exhibition to win the Best in Show Award, based on online votes combined with votes received at the preview in Stratford-upon-Avon. The winner will have the honour of having their artwork used for the promotional material for the Guild Artists Exhibition 2019. Through painting Sarah Jane explores her relationship with her immediate environment, using the landscape metaphorically to examine more emotional concerns. Sarah Jane's natural ability to convey the intensity of her experiences presents an emotional narrative throughout her work, encouraging viewers to connect and engage on a deeper level.

Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK, and her paintings are now collected internationally. An Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, her notable highlights include being selected three times for the Royal Society of Marine Artists Exhibition in London's Mall Galleries, exhibiting at the Cork Street Open exhibition and being selected for the Royal Cambrian Academy Open Exhibition in Conwy earlier this year. Current work is available to view at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, Off The Wall Gallery in Cardiff, the Russell Gallery in Putney, and the Discerner Gallery in Mayfair by appointment.
