Taking place across the Bank Holiday weekend, from Saturday, 27th to Monday, 29th May, Sarah Jane will open her studio to visitors and art collectors keen to look at her latest body of work.

This latest collection explores perspective as a central theme, drawing on the feelings of being outside in nature and the chance it gives us to step back from our busy lives and look around and beyond the humdrum of our everyday routines.

"The magic of being out in the landscape is that it allows us a break from the restrictions and stress of our 21st-century lives, which are dominated by the boxes we live and work in and the screens we stare at for much of the day. Getting outside gives us a different perspective. Science can even prove that shifting our focus to a panoramic view or looking towards the horizon has a calming effect on our brains and even our physiology. Even a simple gaze up at the sky offers us a momentary experience of infinity! These paintings are my way of sharing this sense of perspective and mindfully celebrating the 'headspace' it creates," says Sarah Jane.

The coastal landscape of the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park offers many places to walk and experience, providing Sarah Jane with endless inspiration for her emotionally charged and thought-provoking oil paintings. Her new collection of over 30 paintings will be on view across the weekend in her Brawdy-based studio, and there will be the opportunity to purchase originals from the collection, together with prints and art gifts.

The studio is based at Brawdy Business Park, 1a St Davids House, Brawdy, SA62 6NP, just off the A487 between Penycwm and Solva, and is clearly signposted from the main road. There's plenty of free parking, and refreshments will be on offer throughout the event. Sarah Jane studied Fine Art Painting at the West Wales School of the Arts. Since graduating with a first-class honours degree, her career as a professional artist has steadily gained momentum and recognition. She has exhibited widely across the UK, including at London's Mall Galleries with the Royal Society of Marine Artists and the Royal Cambrian Academy in North Wales, enjoying multiple solo shows and overseas exhibitions. Her work is collected internationally.

In 2020 Sarah Jane was awarded full membership to the Guild Society of Artists, part of the Fine Art Trade Guild, and the right to use the 'GSA' post-nominal letters. The award acknowledges the consistently high standard of her work, as well as her professionalism and business ethics.
