Contemporary landscape painter Sarah Jane Brown recently donated a painting for the Ladies Day 2018 Charity Auction which took place at Dallas Burston Polo Club (DBPC) on Saturday 9th June in Warwickshire.

A popular annual event, the DBPC Ladies Day celebrated its 7th anniversary this year, and raised money for two important charities - The Prince's Trust and The UK Sepsis Trust - in a Charity Auction which took place during the VIP luncheon on the day. At the auction, Sarah Jane's original oil painting 'Ebbing Forces' sold to the highest bidder for £1500.

Sarah Jane was delighted to hear the news, and said 'I am thrilled to have been able to contribute towards the DBPC Ladies Day Charity Auction this year, and to have helped raise money for two remarkable charities; The Prince's Trust who work to create brighter futures for young people, and The UK Sepsis Trust who carry out vital work to improve sepsis care and raise public awareness on this devastating condition.'

Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK, and her paintings are now collected internationally. An Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, her notable highlights include being selected three times for the Royal Society of Marine Artists Exhibition in London's Mall Galleries, exhibiting at the Cork Street Open exhibition and being selected for the Royal Cambrian Academy Open Exhibition in Conwy earlier this year.

Upcoming events include exhibiting at the Russell Gallery's Summer Show in Putney, London 28th June to 8th September, and a solo show at Off The Wall Gallery, Llandaff, Cardiff, 27th October to 21st November.
