Evocative paintings by landscape artist Sarah Jane Brown to feature in the Russell Gallery's Summer Show in London

Contemporary landscape painter Sarah Jane Brown has been invited to feature in the Russell Gallery's Summer Show in Putney, London, which opens with a special preview evening on Tuesday 28th June from 6pm to 8.30pm.

Sarah Jane's three landscape paintings, 'Emotions run deep', 'Instrument of change' and 'Lead me tingling', will be available to view in this mixed exhibition until 8th September, which features established as well as new and emerging artists. A respected modern British art gallery, the Russell Gallery is known for exhibiting an eclectic range of figurative and abstract paintings, primarily in oils and pastels, and often full of colour.

Through painting Sarah Jane explores her relationship with her immediate environment, using the landscape metaphorically to examine more emotional concerns. Sarah Jane's natural ability to convey the intensity of her experiences presents an emotional narrative throughout her work, encouraging viewers to connect and engage on a deeper level.

"The landscape has an immense power to stir emotions in people. I think that's just a real human experience; when we're out in the landscape, it stirs something up. In the process of painting, I go through that range of emotions as well, and then I'm also mindful of the emotive response in the viewer of the end result. Emotion is what drives me because it is such a human thing. I'm trying to communicate something, and I want it to be meaningful to the person that views it."

Sarah Jane has exhibited widely across the UK, and her paintings are now collected internationally. An Associate Member (AGSA) of The Guild Society of Artists, her notable highlights include being selected three times for the Royal Society of Marine Artists Exhibition in London's

Mall Galleries, exhibiting at the Cork Street Open exhibition and being selected for the Royal Cambrian Academy Open Exhibition in Conwy earlier this year. Upcoming events include a solo show at Off The Wall Gallery, Llandaff, Cardiff, 27th October to 21st November. Current work is available to view at Etcetera Gallery in St Davids, Off The Wall Gallery in Cardiff, the Russell Gallery in Putney, and the Discerner Gallery in Mayfair by appointment. 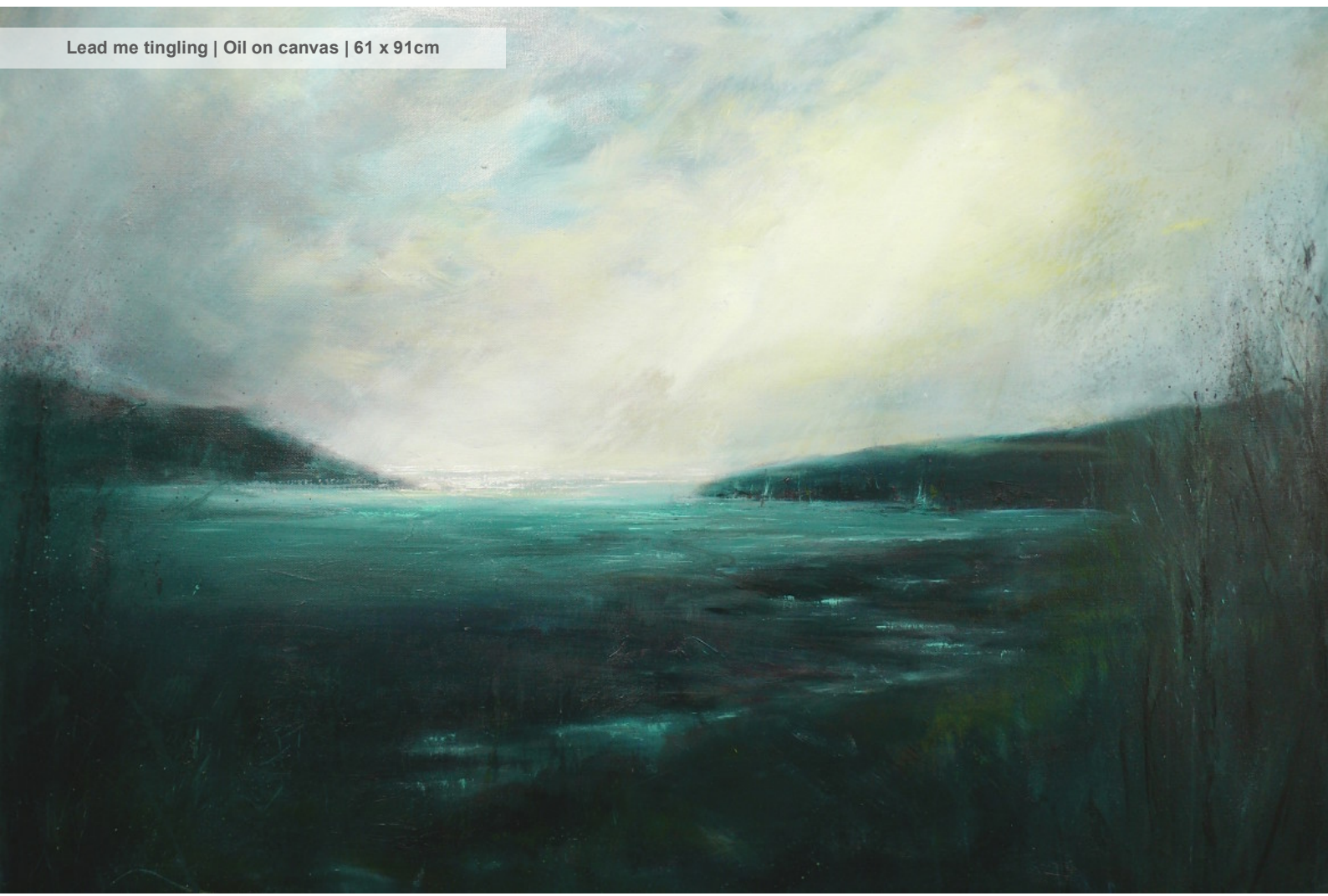
Instrument of change | Oil on canvas board | 24 x 30cm
