

The Little Snail Monica Shell - Why do animals disguise? (4)

Trick, deceive, camouflage - In the garden, not everything is as it seems!

About the book

In four new read-aloud stories, children learn what the local animal world can do in terms of cheating and camouflage. In this volume, Monika Häuschen, a snail, and her two friends, Schorsch, an earthworm, and Günter, a grey goose, meet animals that are masters at deception: Lümmel the cuckoo can fool other parents into thinking he is their offspring. The hoverfly looks like a wasp and thus scares off enemies. Foxes can pretend to be dead and then snatch their prey in a flash. And the fire-bellied toad can camouflage itself so well that it appears invisible. The three friends are amazed at what the other animals can do and also learn that deception is allowed when it comes to survival.


Fire. Water. Earth. Storm. - To Survive You Need All Senses
