SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL ACT 2012

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Section 35 applies to this licence

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012(the Act), JAMES R & TANIA M POWELL (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at 42 Hewletts Road, Mount Maunganui and known as "MYTREAT", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 09:00am - 05:00pm

- No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on 2. 3.
- While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are 4.
- The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages 5.
- A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty at all times, when the premises are open for the
- No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11pm on any day and before 7.
- The licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulation 14 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 to ensure that neither the purchaser nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered is a minor.
- The licensee must state the licensee's name, licence number and date the licence expires:
 - on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely;
 - in every catalogue, if alcohol is sold by remote sale using catalogues; b)
 - on the internet site, if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site; c)
 - if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site, the site must also display either a legible image of the licence, or a clearly d) identified link to such an image. The Licensee must display:
- - At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons; b.
 - At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated at 42 Hewletts Road, Mount Maunganui, is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Tauranga District Licensing Committee on 13th March 2022.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Hewletts Road is designated as the

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation

- Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined. (b)
