

Someone just got an awesome new toy, let's get started.

For ease of shipping and to minimize potential damages or headaches with delivery we use UPS ground on almost all Gator shipments. Due to size and weight restrictions this requires the Gator to be broken into 3 shipments. One shipment will include the hose alone, one shipment includes the reel, and one Shipment includes the Gator and accessory pack. Check out below for simple installation instructions.

Step 1: Unpack the reel

Open and assemble your hose reel. The hardware for the reel is wrapped in paper and stored inside the barrel of the reel. Once the hardware has been recovered, set the barrel of the reel on the mount plate and install the included 4 hex head bolts, washers, and nuts. Install the handle then set the reel aside.

Step 2: Check out the parts, assemble the small stuff.

Remove the battery box from inside your Gator and empty the contents of the box. You will find a hose, hose clamps, inlet screen, hose barbs, gun, etc. These items will be sorted and bagged into individual kits including your spray gun and nozzle kit, your hose reel connection kit, and your spare parts kit. Place these parts aside for use later.

Step 3: Install your battery

Place your battery in the battery box and gently set the battery inside the Gator. Connect the red wires to the positive (B+) terminal of the battery. Connect the black wires to the negative (B-) terminal of the battery. Snap the lid onto the box and affix the included strap.

Step 5: Set the reel on the Gator

Remove the 4 phillips drive bolts and washers on the top of the box. Place the assembled hose reel on top of the box, line up the holes and insert the bolts and washers back into their respective holes.

Step 6: Rewind the hose

Attach the hose barb included with the hose reel to the included application hose (blue or yellow hurricane hose) and clamp using an included stainless steel clamp. Carefully wind this hose onto the reel. Once completed attach your trigger gun with the included clamp.

Step 7: Plumb the reel

Using hose barb included in accessory kit, install barb in hose reel swivel. Connect this hose to the short piece of included hose and clamp both ends.

Step 8: Operation

Connect the Cam-Lock style fitting to the inlet of your Gator, lower the inlet hose into fluid. With the trigger gun open, turn on the power switch to engage the pump. After 20-30 seconds some fluid should flow. Continue to spray until all air is out of the system. Rinse corrosive or acidic chemicals after each use and daily for the longest life. Turn the power switch off when the job is complete.

Step 9: Charging the battery

Recharging your battery using the onboard system is easy. View the right side of the Gator and you will see a round black connector.

Opening this connector reveals a connector for a standard indoor/outdoor extension cord. Plugging this in starts the charging process with no other input from you. Want to use your charger for another battery? No problem. We include an adapter and you can plug that right in!

Step 10: Troubleshooting

Unfortunately sometimes things happen but we have compiled the most common and offer them here to you as suggestions for immediate self-help.

- No power to unit after battery is installed.
 - a) Were the cables tightened onto a proper marine battery?
 - b) Is the battery charged?
 - c) Did you check the fuse in the power cord?
 - d) If none of these resolve this issue please email us at info@pressurecity.com
- 2) Pump is not spraying any fluid
 - a) Is there an air or fluid leak on the suction hose?
 - b) Is the hose fully submerged in water?
- Battery runs out quickly
 - a) Upgrade to a larger AH deep cycle battery or switch to lithium battery
 - b) Make sure you turn the switch off after each use.
- 4) I notice a leak in or around my Gator

a) No worries, all Gators are tested prior to leaving but at times handling in shipment can be a bit bouncy. Usually this causes no issues but occasionally a fitting must be snugged upon arrival. Do not overtighten this as they are plastic. If you are concerned please email us at info@pressurecity.com and we will gladly assist you in this.
