Chinese Tariffs Delayed


Tariff News From The US/China Trade War

On Sunday, in back to back tweets, President Trump reported that there're will be a delay of the additional China tariffs originally scheduled to start on March 1, 2019, as both sides of the trade war continue to make significant progress. The president acknowledges that the two economic giants are rapidly moving forward with the goal of reaching a tentative agreement:

....productive talks, I will be delaying the U.S. increase in tariffs now scheduled for March 1. Assuming both sides make additional progress, we will be planning a Summit for President Xi and myself, at Mar-a-Lago, to conclude an agreement. A very good weekend for U.S. & China!

In addition, President Trump announced that if talks continue to be fruitful, there will be a meeting in the latter half of March at Trump's Mar-a-Lago club in Palm Beach, Florida. These latest discussions are the most recent news after nearly a year of tariff tension between the US and China on tariffs that can affect almost \$720 billion in goods traded.
