1. Haleakalā—"House of the Sun" elevation 10,023 ft. (3,055 m)
2. "L" on Mt. Ball is for Lahainaluna High School
3. Pineapple fields are all over Maui
4. The famous Sugarcane Train and station.
5. Maria Lanakila Catholic Church
6. Flag of the great State of Hawaii
7. Wailoa Church built in 1823, 1832, 1860, and 1894. Oldest church on Maui.
8. The Banyan tree—planted from India in 1873 for the 50th anniversary of Christianity on Maui. It is now over 60 feet tall and covers over 2/3 of an acre.
9. Lahaina Wharf Cinema Center—landmark of Front St. shopping, a tourist must do.
10. Old Lahaina Court house
11. Ruins of the Old Fort
12. The Pioneer Inn—a feature of Lahaina since 1901
13. Baldwin Missionary House Museum—built in 1835, it's the oldest house on Maui.
14. Ship mast flag pole on the pier.
15. Sign for Kimo's Seafood, Steaks, & Grog—great food since 1977
16. Ultimate Whale Watching—since 1982. Whale watching is huge off Maui (see #24.)
17. Finest Kind Sports Fishing—3rd generation. Sport fishing is incredible in the deep Pacific.
18. Atlantis Submarine Tours—go underwater without getting wet for some wonderful sights.
19. Safari Boat Excursions & Tom Barefoot Tours—Snorkeling and scuba excursions are awesome.
20. Hawaiian Shaved Ice is everywhere in Lahaina and it is NOT a snow cone.
21. The Carthaginian II—purchased by Atlantis Subs (#18) for \$1 to create an artificial reef. The permits to sink the ship cost over \$100,000.00.
22. Roxie the Tugboat is a mainstay in the harbor.
23. The harbor break water and anchorage.
24. Humpback Whales come to the waters off of Maui to calf from December through March. The area has been made a sanctuary, quite different from the whaling days.
25. Atlantis Submarine—Eco friendly underwater tours to see the reef and the Carthaginian II.
26. There is amazing sea life to be seen by snorkeling and scuba diving.
27. Green and Hawksbill Sea Turtles are common in the Hawaiian waters.
28. Maui has some brilliant and diverse coral reefs.
