



NIAGARA FALLS

Located between Ontario and New York, Niagara Falls is an iconic tourist destination. With a vertical drop of over 165 feet, the falls have the highest flow rate of any waterfall in the world. In this painting, Eric captures tourists enjoying the view from a variety of locations—a bridge, boats, lookouts, and even a tightrope!

1. Niagara Falls straddles the U.S. border with Canada
2. Tours of the falls are great to learn the history of the falls
3. In 1901 school teacher Annie Taylor was the first to survive going over the falls and she took her cat with her.
4. The Maid of the Mist has been taking visitors up to the falls since 1846.
5. The Mystery Machine
6. Niagara Falls straddles the Canadian border with the U.S.

8. Observation Deck at Niagara Falls State Park
9. Eric met a couple from his birthplace in Boise, ID so he had to include them in the painting.
10. In 1960 7 year old Roger Woodward was swept over the falls when the boat he was in capsized. He miraculously survived the plunge and was rescued below the falls (*see #16.*)

12. The Lelawala was the first Maid of the Mist—named for an Indian maiden.

15. Walking a wire across the falls was a common practice in the late 1800’s but was not allowed for 115 years until Nik Walenda did the feat again in 2012.
16. (*See #10*) Roger’s sister was rescued by a visitor looking at the falls from Goat Island. That is her reaching up over the rail.
