The city of Paris was founded on a bend on the Seine River thousands of years ago and named after the Celtic Parisii tribe. During the Age of Enlightenment the nom du jour became the City of Light due to it being a center of education. The name took on additional meaning in 1800's when Paris became the first city illuminated by street lamps. In this painting, by Eric Dowdle, Paris at night glows in a gown of golden light flowing across her classic architecture, with Notre Dame in the fore, the Eiffel Tower rising over the Seine, and the Tour Monparnasse in the back ground.
